

To ensure everyone's health and safety as we return to creating together during the COVID-19 pandemic, we have put in place numerous measures in accordance with the provincial guidelines to allow for safe theatre making together. We will be re-evaluating as the 21-22 theatre season progresses and making the appropriate changes necessary.

The following list includes protocols that have been put in place to ensure everyone's health and safety. Please read carefully.

Please do not hesitate to call us if you have any questions or concerns.

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- Classes are of a duration of one hour each.
 - Classes take place in the Studio with a maximum of six students, one instructor and one assistant.
 - Only students and staff are permitted in the building. Door monitors will help direct students during outdoor drop-off and pick-up.
 - High traffic surface areas will be sanitized between classes.
 - Handwashing and sanitization are required of students and staff.
 - Students are required to wear a mask while in the building and during classes.
 - Exemptions will be made for students who cannot wear a mask for medical reasons. Please contact us prior to the start of classes to discuss.
 - Students are encouraged to bring their own mask. Disposable masks are available for students.
 - All TCM Theatre School staff are vaccinated and are required to wear a mask.
 - All students and staff must screen for symptoms before coming to Theatre School. If a student has COVID-19 or flu related symptoms, please keep them at home. If a staff member has COVID-19 or flu related symptoms, they will stay at home and another staff member will lead the class.
 - Please bring water from home. Water fountains are not accessible in the building.
 - Please wear comfortable clothing and indoor shoes.
 - To discourage students from touching their faces, we recommend students tie long hair back before coming to class.
 - Should the provincial guidelines require a shutdown due to COVID-19, all classes will be offered online.
